#### **Variable Stars**

- > Variable stars are stars that change in brightness.
- The study of variable stars gives information on how stars are formed, live and die and what changes occur internally and externally as they evolve as well as the environments surrounding them, including planets and other companions.

# Can we contribute to changing this

- mapThe unaided eye is sufficient for bright stars, while for fainter stars you a telescope is needed.
  - Observers send their data to Headquarter, where they are checked processed and added to the AAVSO international Database.
  - Members and observers have a unique opportunity to present and exchange ideas at the AAVSO meetings and publish in peer-review journals.

## Planning ahead:

- We are working on translating the observer manual to Arabic.
- In my astrophysics course next semester this will be the research project for my students.
- We have a large number of observers in the different countries. I propose starting a group in the Arab countries for this observing program.
